Article 02 Add to School Facilities/Improvements Capital Reserve

Article 03 School Board Contingency Fund

Article 04 Operating Budget

Shall the Rumney School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling three million four hundred fifteen thousand five hundred three dollars (\$3,415,503)? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be three million three hundred thirteen thousand four hundred sixty dollars (\$3,313,460), which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Rumney School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. **The School Board Recommends this article.** (Majority vote required.)



**Article 3: Operating Budget**

Shall the Pemi-Baker Regional School District vote to raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session for the purposes set forth therein, totaling fifteen million, seven hundred seventy-two thousand nine hundred thirty-four dollars (\$15,772,934)?

Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be fifteen million four hundred ninety thousand seven hundred nineteen dollars (\$15,490,719), which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Pemi-Baker Regional School Board, or by law or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. This sum excludes the sum in Warrant Articles 2. The School Board recommends this article. (Majority vote required.)
