Ambulance Service Contract: Mark will draft a letter to the Town of Plymouth regarding two minor changes in wording that the board would like to have in the contract before they sign it.

Latulippe Gravel Pit Update: Janice updated the board on the latest Planning Board meeting. Janice will contact Don Jutton of MRI to make sure that the town's best interests are being met by MRI. The Planning Board feels that Mr. Latulippe is currently following the appropriate process and is working towards getting things done.

Foreco Request – A letter will be sent to FORECO regarding their request for Temporary Use/Logging. The board will not sign the request because the town is not permitted to encumber property that has a purchase and sales agreement. The town currently has a purchase and sales agreement with the US Forest Service on the land that FORECO is requesting use of.

Nory Parr, Conservation Commission met with the board to update them on what the Commission is working on. They have developed a draft work plan, plan to hold workshops for the community during the year and will host the Community Profile in May.
