SELECTMEN'S MEETING
MINUTES
03/19/07

The meeting was opened at 7:00 pm.

MINUTES: The minutes of 03-12-07 were approved.

SELECTMEN'S ISSUES:

US Forest Service Land Purchase – Ken Crevier and Bill Dauer of the USFS met with the board to discuss the Forest Service's purchase of the Cook Lot. The paperwork will be signed by two selectmen at tonight's meeting and the third signature will be provided on March 28th at the Registry of Deeds. At this time the sale will be completed and the check will be turned over to the town. The USFS would like the town to note that there will be no PILT (payment in lieu of taxes) on this property since there were no taxes collected on the property because it was owned by the town.

Chairman & Dept. Assignments: A motion was made and seconded to elect Mark Andrew as Chairman of the Board of Selectmen. The board voted unanimously to elect Mark Andrew as Chairman.

Department Liaison Assignments were made as follows:

Mark Andrew: Police, Fire, Emergency Management

Janice Mulherin: Planning Board, School, Town Office Finance

John Fucci: Transfer Station, Highway

Conservation Commission Appointments: A motion was made to appoint Maggie Brox, Dave Coursey and Joel Grass to the Conservation Commission for a 3 year term. This motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

At 8:00 the board voted unanimously to enter into Nonpublic Session per RSA 91-A:3 II (b) to discuss assessing. At 8:20pm the board voted unanimously to leave Nonpublic Session. No decisions were made.

ADMINISTRATIVE:

Use of Common – Jon Poitras has made a request to use the common on June 23, 2007 for a wedding. Anne will send him the appropriate paperwork and suggest he check with the Police Department about traffic control.

Intent to Cut Extension – The board received a written request from Wade Reed, Logger for an extension on the Intent to Cut filed for the Faulkner property. Anne will look into this because the request may need to come from the landowner.

Skipper – Tree/Power Line – The road agent has looked at the area in question and feels the tree is owned by the landowner. Mr. Skipper spoke with Mark Andrew on the telephone about this issue but has not yet made a formal request to the town.

Septic Plans/Rumney Campground – The board is waiting for the application before the plans are reviewed for approval.

Assessing: Two contracts from CNP were reviewed. One is for General Assessing and one is for a Cyclical Revaluation. A change in wording needs to be made to the contract for Cyclical Revaluation and then both contracts will be signed at the same time.
