The meeting was opened at 7:00 pm.

**MINUTES:** The minutes of 04-30-07 were approved.

**SELECTMEN'S ISSUES:**

**COMMUNITY PROFILE RECAP:** The Community Profile was held on Friday and Saturday and was a success. There will be a follow-up meeting on May 23<sup>rd</sup> from 6-8pm for those that attended. The facilitators and organizers of the event are preparing a book/handout on the event.

**FAST SQUAD:** Mark Andrew explained to the board that the Fast Squad is looking into licensing the Fast Squad vehicle with the state to be a transport vehicle. There will not be any town money used to outfit the vehicle to make it a transport vehicle, donations will be used. Transport would be provided only when the Plymouth ambulance was not available.

**CNP (Assessing)** – A draft press release was reviewed. This release will not go out until just before CNP begins the information gathering process which should begin in late summer. Mark Neider of CNP will meet with Anne on Wednesday to discuss the pick-ups that need to be done. The board discussed how to best inform the public of the process. The press release will go in local papers, the town website and posted at local stores. The possibility of holding a public hearing was also discussed.

**Meeting Schedule:** The board discussed meeting and signing checks every other week. The board will not meet on May 28<sup>th</sup> and then will try meeting every other week throughout the summer. Checks will be signed weekly.

**Police Chief, Bill Main** met with the board at the board's request to discuss speed on Route 25. Bill will write a letter to the State of NH, Department of Transportation asking them to review Route 25 due to increased traffic and development along Route 25.

**ADMINISTRATIVE:**

**Recreation Committee:** Peggy Grass would like to meet with the board to discuss reactivating the Recreation Committee and possibly having members appointed by the board. Anne will review records to see how the committee was formed and if there are any specific guidelines.

**Ambulance Contract:** The board is still waiting for wording changes before signing the contract. A letter to the Town of Plymouth was reviewed and signed requesting the wording changes.

**MOW BIDS:** Bids will be opened next week.
