SELECTMEN'S MEETING

The meeting was opened at 7:00 pm.

MINUTES: The minutes of 05-07-07 were approved.

SELECTMEN'S ISSUES:

Randy Latulippe: Mr. Latulippe met with the board to discuss the non-conforming lot letter that he received. Mr. Latulippe explained that there had been a guest staying in the apartment but they are no longer there. He asked if he was now in compliance since there is no one staying in the apartment. The board agreed that yes he is now in compliance. The apartment can be used for incidental use only. Anne will send a letter to Mr. Latulippe with a copy to the town attorney clarifying that the non-conforming issue has been corrected.

Abatements: The board reviewed three abatements with Arthur Morrill.

Martha Richards, Grafton County Commissioner: Martha Richards met with the board to update them on the County budget and pending projects. She also informed the board that there is a County budget hearing on Monday, May 21st at 6:00. The Grafton County website is: www.graftoncountynh.us

Mow Bids: Two mow bids were received and opened. Bids were received from Oikle & Sons and Accel 1 Property Maintenance. After reviewing the bids the board voted unanimously to award the mow bid to Oikle & Sons. Anne will notify both bidders of the decision.

ADMINISTRATIVE:

FEMA Meeting: Anne and Frank Simpson, Road Agent, attended the meeting held on Wednesday in Bristol. A FEMA representative will contact the town to review areas that were damaged and discuss the procedure for requesting reimbursement.

Health Insurance: The town was contacted by SAU48 about combining with the SAU for health insurance. The plan is the same one the town is enrolled in now and there would be no change in health benefits. There would, however, be a significant savings to the town because we would be part of a larger pool of subscribers. The board discussed this and agreed to go forward with the change which will be effective July 1, 2007.

Collery Abatement: A request was made to file an abatement after the March 1, 2007 deadline. The property owner was away and there was a mix-up in the mail delivery. The board denied the request to file a late abatement. The board will ask the assessor to review the property card to see if an error was made.
