SELECTMEN'S MEETING

MINUTES

05/21/07

The meeting was opened at 7:00 pm. The board met with Frosty Sobetzer and a few other townspeople at the Quincy Ballfield to discuss the possibility of putting in an ice rink at the field.

MINUTES: The minutes of 05-14-07 were approved.

SELECTMEN'S ISSUES:

RUMNEY BEAUTIFICATION WEEK – The board discussed “Rumney Beautification Week” and Amnesty Day at the Transfer Station. Wording for a press release was reviewed and will be finalized for publication in newspapers and on the town website. Sonny Ouellette, Transfer Station Superintendent, was also present for the discussion. He will get two extra containers for the Amnesty Day. Hazardous waste items and vehicles will not be accepted. Items that are normally accepted will be accepted on Amnesty Day with no charge. Sonny also has some contacts for residents who may have junk cars they would like to get rid of.

Tom Duffield of TF Moran met with the board to discuss the landfill closure. Three rounds of sampling have been completed since the test wells were installed. There have been no significant findings. The Hydro geological report is almost complete. Mr. Duffield explained to the board that he needs to finalize the report and the cost would be approximately \$1000.00. When the report is finalized it can be submitted to the State of NH. The board agreed to have Mr. Duffield finalize the report and submit it to the board for review before it is sent to the State of NH.

Rescue 1 – The Fast Squad vehicle is temporarily out of service while it is being repaired.

Senior Awards – A Selectmen representative is needed to hand out scholarships at the PRHS Senior Awards to be held on June 5. John will check his schedule and see if he is available.

ADMINISTRATIVE:

Historical Society Roof – Roger Daniels reported that there was some damage done to the roof. Anne has called Bob LaCourse and he will repair the roof as soon as possible.

Timber Tax Levels - Levels need to be assigned within the next week or so. Janice will work on this.

Darling Land Sale – The Attorney has reported that progress is being made slowly on this transaction.

FEMA Update – Anne and Frank met with the FEMA representative on Wednesday and he will be in Rumney this week to view the damage in Rumney.

Current Use Application – Three Current Use Applications were reviewed.

Abatements – Eight abatement applications were reviewed.
