The meeting was opened at 7:00 pm.

**MINUTES:** The minutes of 08-13-07 were approved.

**SELECTMEN'S ISSUES:**

**Blair/Darling Land Purchase:** Mark & Jennifer Blair brought the deed in for the board to sign. The deed was signed and will be sent to the town's attorney on Tuesday. Our attorney will take the deed to the registry on Thursday. The check will be ready next Wednesday.

**Stinson Lake Road Speed Limit:** John Fucci met with Bill Lambert of the State of NH DOT. They traveled the road and looked at signage. The state will be putting up some additional signage. John reported that speed has become more of a problem since the road was newly paved. He and Mr. Lambert discussed putting in seasonal speed bumps. Mr. Lambert will discuss this with his supervisor. The state would provide the speed bumps and the town would need to maintain them. This would amount to putting them in place and removing them. Mr. Lambert will get back to the town about this matter.

**Voices Against Violence:** Jaye Olmstead, Director, met with the board. She thanked the town for their continued support and offered to answer any questions the board might have.

**Rink Committee:** Peggy Grass, Carl Spring and Frosty Sobetzer met with the board to discuss plans for the skating rink at the Quincy Ballfield. As a result of the Community Profile discussions the Recreation Committee has been re-organized and the Rink Facilities Committee was formed to work on the skating rink project. Frosty Sobetzer is the Chairman of the Facilities Committee. The committee has been meeting every other Friday at 7:30pm. Meeting notes are being kept and will be turned in to the Town Clerk. A plan for the skating rink was submitted to the board. The goal is to put in a small rink for skating this year. Anne suggested the committee put together a budget for the 2008 budget. The culvert at the entrance to the field needs to be replaced. Carl Spring is checking with the State about replacing it and Anne will check with Frank. There is a brush pile that needs to be burned and they will check with the Fire Chief and also notify the neighbors. They will also be meeting with the neighbors at the field to discuss any concerns the abutters may have. The committee would also like to put up a sign at the field. Anne will check on the exact name of the field.
