SELECTMEN'S MEETING
MINUTES
09/17/07

At 6:30pm the board met at the Quincy Ballfield with Frosty Sobetzer to view the site for the skating rink. The brush pile will be burned this Saturday. There should be about 6" of good top soil to scrape off and it will be stockpiled for town use.

The meeting was opened at 7:00 pm at the Town Office Building.

MINUTES: The minutes of 09-10-07 were approved.

SELECTMEN'S ISSUES:

Junkyard Procedures – The notice will be placed in the paper by October 1st. The board agreed that if anyone calls the office for information they will take names and phone numbers and information will be sent out when available. There is a workshop being held on October 22, 2007 at LGC. John Fucci will attend and Anne will check with the Health Officer and the Police Chief to see if they are available.

Selectperson's Institute – John Fucci will attend the meeting on September 29th.

Communication – The board discussed the need to formalize a procedure for communication. All agreed that all correspondence/communications, specifically e-mails, need to go through the Selectmen's Office and Anne and have an official Town of Rumney return e-mail address.

ADMINISTRATION:

Ron Comeau -Non Conforming Lot – This is moving forward. Mr. Comeau will be served with paperwork in the next month.

East Rumney Road/NH Co-op Maintenance – The Co-op began the tree maintenance on East Rumney Road.

Fountain Ownership – The questions of ownership was raised by the Local Government Center for insurance purposes. It can be added to the town's policy if it is owned by the town. Anne has done some research on this and there is very little information. The board suggested meeting with the committee to discuss this.

Authorization – The board agreed to give Sonny Ouellette authorization to apply for and sign DES Grants for the Town of Rumney. All grant paperwork should be brought before the board for their review.

CNP – A representative from CNP will begin data collection on Monday, September 24th. The notice will be posed around town, on the website and in the local paper. Postcards will also be sent to property owners and will be mailed Tuesday by CNP.
