SELECTMEN'S MEETING

The meeting was opened at 7:00 pm.

MINUTES: The minutes of 09-17-07 were approved.

SELECTMEN'S ISSUES:

Junkyard Procedures – The process to be used was discussed further. The notice will be placed in the Record Citizen, The Pennysaver and on the town website. Anne will outline a timeline and the process.

Ambulance Advisory Committee – The board received notification of a meeting on October 9, 2007 at 2:00pm. Mark would like to attend but cannot at that time. The board will send a letter to Chief Thibeault and the other towns involved asking for a different meeting time.

Groton C&D/Transfer Station – Some Groton residents have asked to bring C&D to the Rumney Transfer Station because Groton will no longer accept C&D. The board discussed this and will check with Sonny to get his opinion.

Building Committee – The committee held their first meeting and put together some preliminary ideas. The next meeting will be October 11, 2007 at 7:00pm.

ADMINISTRATION:

Ron Comeau -Non Conforming Lot – Mr. Comeau has not officially answered the court order but has said that the tenants have moved out. The board will wait for official notification from Mr. Comeau.

Onofrio – The town was notified that the Town of Rumney will be served with paperwork from the Grafton Superior Court in a case filed by Onofrio Revocable Trust concerning property taxes. In the past the town has hired Upton & Hatfield to handle these types of cases. The board discussed this and voted unanimously to hire Upton & Hatfield to handle the Onofrio case when officially served with the paperwork.

Ice Rink Donation – The town received a \$250.00 donation from Michael Cersosimo for the ice rink at the Quincy field.

At 9:00 pm the board voted unanimously to enter into Non-Public Session per RSA 91-A:3 II (a) to discuss compensation of an employee. The board agreed that the employee was due compensation for the time worked. At 9:20 the board voted unanimously to leave non-public session.
