SELECTMEN'S MEETING

11/05/07

The meeting was opened at 7:00 pm.

MINUTES: The minutes of 10-29-07 were approved.

SELECTMEN'S ISSUES:

The board presented **Linda Whitcomb, Town Clerk/Tax Collector**, with a plaque and a clock in honor of 20 years of service and dedication to the Town of Rumney.

Bob Berti: Mr. Berti met with the board to give an update on the Pemi-Baker Solid Waste District and discuss how the town will use the proceeds from the sale of the woodlot. Mr. Berti also pointed out that there are several rails at the town common that have fallen down and would like to see these put back up and fixed.

Rumney Register – John Fucci reported that the register will go out this week.

Assessing Practices – The information is still being reviewed and will be available soon.

Building Committee Update – Tom Wallace reviewed preliminary plans with the Police Chief and town office staff.

East Rumney Road/Coop Tree Cutting – The trimming is still going on. Frosty Sobetzer, an East Rumney Road resident, spoke with the coop about the trimming and Mr. Bradley, who is heading the project for the coop, has been out to East Rumney Road with the trimming crew.

ADMINISTRATION:

Groton Hollow Road – Brad Shanks a resident of Groton Hollow Road made a complaint about speeding log trucks on the road. This will be referred to the Police Department.

Junkyard Update – The notice was placed in the paper. The Selectmen reviewed a list of properties with areas that may fall under the junkyard status. The board discussed whether or not to have MRI involved in the process and they agreed to consult with them for advice and then at a later date for enforcement.

Class VI Road – The Zielinski's are interested in purchasing a property that is on a Class VI road and would like the town to change the status of the road to a Class V road. The board would like the Zielinski's to come into a meeting to discuss this issue.

CDBG/\$10,000 - When the town receives the \$10,000 from the CDBG settlement, there needs to be a public hearing to accept the money per the DRA.
