The meeting was opened at 7:00 pm.

**MINUTES:** The minutes of 11-19-07 were approved.

**SELECTMEN'S ISSUES:**

**Assessing Practices** – The information was reviewed and approved for distribution. The information will be placed on the town website.

**Tom Grabiek** – Tom Grabiek met with the board representing the Economic Development/Zoning Committee which was formed as a result of the Community Profile. The Committee met during the summer and discussed whether it would be feasible to approach the town with warrants/articles in 2008. The committee would like direction from the board as to developing warrant articles on issues that might concern residents of the town. After some discussion all agreed that time would not allow for any articles on the 2008 warrant. The board suggested Mr. Grabiek and other committee members meet with the Planning Board to discuss this matter.

**Highway Budget** – The board met with Frank Simpson to review the 2008 proposed budget.

**Gravel Excavation Bids** – Only one bid was received. The bid was from DA White for gravel excavation on Buffalo Road. The bid was for \$21,800. A motion was made and seconded to accept this bid. The board voted unanimously to accept the bid and the board signed the contract.

**Hunter Subdivision/Tree** – Frank Simpson asked for the board's approval to remove a tree on East Rumney Road. The tree needs to be cut/removed in order for a large rock to be removed for a safer access. The board approved removal of the tree.

**ADMINISTRATION:**

**Blair/Darling Property - Committee** – The board is ready to set up a committee. Anne will contact potential members and set up a meeting date. The board will also draft a charge for the committee.

**Energy Audit** – A representative from NH Electric Coop met with Anne. He prepared a preliminary report with some suggestions for energy savings. There will be a more extensive review done at a later date.

**Ratio Study** – The preliminary information was reviewed by the board.
