The meeting was opened at 7:00 pm.

**MINUTES:** The minutes of 11-26-07 were approved.

**SELECTMEN'S ISSUES:**

**Deputy Health Officer** – The appointment form was signed appointing John Dewever as Deputy Health Officer.

**Town Report Bids** – Bids received were: True Colors - \$2,396; Sherwin Dodge - \$2345; Taylor Made \$2,568. The board reviewed the bids and voted to accept the bid from True Colors at \$2,396.00 for printing the 2007 Town Report.

**Property Tax Interest** – Due to the inclement weather on December 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>, the board agreed to waive interest until December 6, 2007 on the current tax bill that was due December 3, 2007.

**Budgets:**

**Recreation Committee** – The board met with Frosty Sobetzer and Peggy Grass to review the Recreation budget. This includes a request for money for the rink project at the Baker Athletic Field and a request for money for a summer camp program. These items will be separate warrant articles. \$1400 will be added to the Quincy Ballfield line item for a port-a-potty for the field.

**Town Clerk/Tax Collector** – The board met with Linda Whitcomb to review her budget.

**Police Department** – The board met with Chief Main to review the police department budget. A warrant article for the purchase of tasers will be included in the 08 warrant.

**ADMINISTRATION:**

**BTLA Timely Filing** – After further review of the Stiles case, it was determined that it was filed timely with the BTLA. There was a grace period because of the Labor Day Holiday; therefore the board cannot raise a timely filing issue.

**Timber Tax** – Janice will review the reports of wood cut and put the appropriate levels on them.

**PILOT** – The payment in lieu of taxes was received from Salem Children's Trust and the Hunter School.

**R. Comeau – Non Conforming Lot Issue** – The board is waiting for Don Smith, Planning Board Chairman to check the property for tenants so the case can be closed. Anne will send a reminder to Don.

**Digitizing Maps** – Anne contacted Cartographics and they would like to meeting with the board before submitting a quote on digitizing the maps. Anne will set this up.

**CNP Assessing** – CNP has completed the first 50% of the data collection and has asked if they can begin the second half early. The board discussed this and agreed they want to wait until 2008 as originally agreed upon. The cards will be sent out in mid-December to the remainder of the property owners who will be visited in 2008.

**Septic Plan** – A septic plan submitted for 13-03-38, Thompson Farm Lane was reviewed. The plan will be sent back to the designer. The board has some questions and concerns that need to be answered before they will approve the plan.
