The meeting was opened at 7:00 p.m.

MINUTES: The minutes of February 11, 2008 were accepted as written.

APPOINTMENTS:

7:15 Don Jutton and Ken Knowlton from MRI, Inc. met with the Board to discuss their role with the enforcement of the junk yard laws as well as an estimate of costs associated with their involvement. MRI will work on an as-needed basis using an hourly rate. It was agreed to propose \$10,000 (warrant article #6 will have to be amended from \$5,000 to \$10,000) at town meeting for this work. MRI will forward a draft contract within the next few weeks for the Board's review. The Board will begin the preliminary steps for enforcement in the spring.

8:00 **Teresa Medaglia** and several other residents met with the Board to discuss their concerns with a sex offender living in town. Chief Main was present to provide information and answer questions. Chief Main talked about pending legislation and encouraged residents to contact their representatives regarding the bill. Mrs. Medaglia asked the Board to consider adopting an ordinance with restrictions as to where such an individual could live in town. The Board will take her request under advisement and review the town's options.

**SELECTMEN'S ISSUES**

**Racine's Driveway** (Wheeler Lane) – Janice attended a meeting at the school last week with Gordon Racine and Kim Cattucci (school custodian). Jeremy Haney, the contractor hired to take care of the snow plowing this year, was also asked to attend; however, it was snowing and he was not available. Mr. Racine has been less than satisfied with the way his driveway has been maintained this winter. The custodian will discuss the matter with Mr. Haney. Janice will be attending an upcoming school board meeting to discuss the matter with them.

## **ADMINISTRATIVE**

**Bobcat Repairs** – The Bobcat is in Concord for repairs; estimate for the immediate repairs is \$1,000 and about \$5,000 to take care of all repairs that should be done. The cost for the rental machine will be about \$1,000 also. The Board agreed to have the initial \$1,000 repairs done at this time. Anne will contact the DRA to discuss a possible amendment to Article #24 to help out with funding the repairs. The Board will look into options for next year for an upgrade (lease, purchase, grants, etc.).

**Time Warner/Internet Service** – Anne has contacted Time Warner about the residents in Rumney still without internet service. Time Warner will look into this matter and get back to the town in the near future.

**Karanuik Septic System** – Anne has left several messages at DES for a call back. Before the Board will approve the septic plans, they need some input from the DES on several areas of concern with the plans. The Board sent a letter to them in December and again in January. The town has not received a response from them yet. Anne will continue to contact them for their response and ask Mr. Karanuik and his septic designer to do the same.

**UPCOMING:** Town Elections/Voting is Tuesday, March 11, 8 a.m.- 7 p.m., at the school. Town Meeting is Tuesday, March 18, 7:00 p.m. at the school.
