APPOINTMENTS

7:15 Deb Dickman, owner of the Rumney Village Store, met with the Board to discuss concern over the lack of community support of local businesses. Discussion followed on possible ways to promote local businesses. She brought up the fact that there is no longer a trail for snowmobiles to get through the village; the State does not allow the corridor trail to cross where it used to due to a visibility issue. The Board suggested she contact the local clubs and work with them on the trail issue.

SELECTMEN'S ISSUES

Janice reported on the Ambulance Advisory Committee meeting she attended earlier in the day. The "Write-off Policy" is going to be revised to have application go to the individual's town first (they generally have a better understanding of the person's financial situation) before going to the Plymouth Fire Chief. She reported the call volume is down in all the participating towns.

School Meeting – Janice attended the Rumney School District's budget hearing; their budget is down 4.3% over last year's.

Municipal Law Update – Anne will schedule Attorney Waugh's annual visit for a date after the February 9th budget hearing. Planning Board members will be invited to attend.

Current Use – Changes have been proposed to the existing current use rates; Janice will review the information.

The selectmen will not meet on January 19; the next meeting will be Monday, January 26.
