Appointments

7:15 - Lynn Mayo submitted plans for the revised septic system for the Beckett House Tax Map # 12-15-15. The current system has failed. The Board reviewed the plans and approved them as shown.

7:30 – John and Dottie Patterson met with the Board about his recent departure from employment at the Transfer Station. Mr. Patterson asked for this discussion to be public. He expressed his concerns about the reasons for the decision to let him go. The Board thanked him for his 10 years of service.

Selectmen's Issues

Forest Service/Buffalo Road Driveway Permit – The Board reviewed the letter sent by John Bagley of the Driveway Unit to the White Mountain National Forest regarding their driveway permit. Work has begun on the site before the completion of the Town's driveway permit process. The Board is in agreement with the points Mr. Bagley stated in his letter. Anne will check with the contractor to make sure all necessary permits are in place.

Personnel – The Board reviewed an application for a new employee at the Transfer Station. The Board agreed to hire the individual as a part-time employee.

Auditors – The Board will ask for several quotes for municipal audit services from several firms.

Update Lighting – The Board will request quotes for updating the lighting in the town office building.

Non-Public Session – The Board voted unanimously to enter into non-public session at 8:07 p.m. under RSA 91:A:3 (c). The Board voted to leave non-public session at 8:15 p.m. No decisions were made.
