The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

APPOINTMENTS

7:15 Toni Goss met with the Board to discuss some concerns she had with the Highway Department's plowing of East Rumney Road. She felt on a few occasions there was no need to be plowing. The Board stated that they leave the decisions of when and where to plow up to the Road Agent, but they will make sure he is aware of her concerns.

ADMINISTRATIVE

Groton Wind – The Board reviewed several documents and letters to the SEC regarding the Groton Wind project. One letter from Richard Barnes was to the Board questioning their position on the project. The Board will send a letter in response.

Meeting Room computer will have to be upgraded; Anne will look into options.

Advisory Committee – The selectmen will invite the Advisory Committee to meet with them on January 10 for a budget review.

Correspondence – The Board received a letter from a taxpayer regarding the inventory penalty he was assessed. He said he sent the form in, the office has no record of receiving it. The Board remains consistent with the handling of these penalties. The penalty will stand unless there is sufficient evidence/reasons to abate it.

SELECTMEN'S ISSUES

Road Committee update - John reported that Joe Shilansky, Carl Spring, Frosty Sobetzer and himself met for a meeting last Thursday; Frank was not available. They discussed the committee handbook and requested copies for each of them; continuation of road improvements on Buffalo Road; capital reserve accounts, bridges, etc. Another meeting will be set up the first of the year with Frank for further discussion.

Warren-Wentworth Ambulance Contract was signed.

Lightfoot Settlement – The Board reviewed Phil Bodwell's recommendation for a settlement. The Board voted 3-0 to accept the recommendation. This will eliminate the need for a BTLA hearing. Mr. Bodwell will notify the BTLA of the settlement. A refund will be issued to the Lightfoot's next week.

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The Board reviewed the **legal update from LGC** regarding compensation and code enforcement issues. The Board will invite the Fire Commissioners and Fire Chief to meet with them within the next two weeks to discuss further.

BUDGET REVIEW – The Board continued with their budget review.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:30 p.m.
