Chairman Haskell opened the meeting at 5:30 p.m.

He stated the purpose for the meeting was to finalize the agreement for the Officer-in-Charge position (police) and to discuss the hiring process for the next police chief. Chief Bill Main has retired from the department as of July 27<sup>th</sup>.

Mark recommended the Board talk with Bill Main about the long and short term plans he had for the department and any suggestions he could give the Board to continue moving the Town and the Department forward.

At 5:35 Cheryl Lewis made a motion to enter into non-public session under RSA91-A:3, II (a), seconded by Dan Kimble and voted 3-0. A motion was made by Dan Kimble to leave non-public session at 6:10, seconded by Ed Haskell and voted 3-0. No decisions were made.

6:15 Brett Miller met with the Board at their request. At 6:17 Ed Haskell made a motion to enter into non-public session under RSA91-A:3, II (a), seconded by Dan Kimble and voted 3-0. At 7:00 a motion was made by Ed Haskell to leave non-public session, seconded by Dan Kimble and voted 3-0. The Board appointed Brett Miller as Officer-in-Charge of the Rumney Police Department effective today through October 26, 2014. The Officer-in-Charge agreement was signed by both parties.

Ed Haskell left the meeting for a prior commitment.

Cheryl and Dan reviewed the current job description and discussed the application and wording for the posting of the position. They will work on these this week and plan to finalize them at next week's meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
