ARTICLE 1: To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate one hundred four thousand dollars (\$104,000) and to further authorize and empower the School Board to borrow up to \$104,000 representing a portion of the State of New Hampshire's share of special education costs for the 2016-2017 school year, pursuant to RSA 198:20-d upon such terms and conditions as the School Board determines in the best interests of the District; said sum together with the costs of borrowing to be repaid by the State of New Hampshire pursuant to RSA 198:20-d; or to take any action in relation thereto. The School Board recommends this article. (Majority vote required.)

ARTICLE 2: To see if the School District will vote to establish a contingency fund for the current year for unanticipated expenses that may arise and further to raise and appropriate two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) to put in the fund. This sum to come from {local taxation}. Any appropriation left in the fund at the end of the year will lapse to the general fund. (Majority vote required.)

ARTICLE 3: To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to be added to the School District Facilities Capital Reserve Fund previously established. The School Board recommends this article. (Majority vote required.)

ARTICLE 4: To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of up to seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to be added to the School District Facilities Capital Reserve Fund previously established. **This sum to come from June 30 fund balance available for transfer on July 1.** No amount to be raised from taxation. School Board recommends this article. (Majority vote required.)

ARTICLE 5: Shall the Rumney School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session for the purposes set forth therein, totaling two million six hundred ninety-seven thousand six hundred eleven dollars (\$2,697,611).

Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be two million six hundred ninety eight thousand four hundred eighty seven dollars (2,698,487), which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Rumney School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. The School Board recommends this article. (Majority vote required.)
